

Cleveland Clinic Cancer Institute Collaborates with Cleveland Home and Garden Show to Offer Mobile Mammogram Screenings

Cleveland, OH — February 5,6 and 7th — Cleveland Clinic Cancer Institute's Community Outreach and Patient Navigation team is collaborating with the Cleveland Home and Garden Show to bring life-saving breast cancer screenings directly to the community. A **Mobile Mammogram Clinic** will be available during the event 11 am - 6 pm, increasing access to preventive care for those who may not have access to breast cancer screening.

Who is Eligible?

- Women, **40 years or older**, or with a **family history of breast cancer**
- Last mammogram must have been **at least 366 days ago**
- Must **not be experiencing symptoms or pain**
- **No physician order required** — a dedicated Nurse Practitioner will review all orders and results
- Patients with **nipple piercings** or **breast implants** are welcome

No Insurance?

Cancer screenings are usually covered by most insurance plans. For individuals who are uninsured or underinsured, financial assistance is available to those who qualify

What to Expect:

- Screenings will be conducted by Cleveland Clinic.
- Our Nurse Practitioner will oversee all clinical reviews.
- Patient Navigators will follow up with results and provide guidance for next steps.

Breast cancer is one of the most common cancers among women, and mammograms can help catch the disease early when it's easier to treat.
